The Kings Mountain Art Fair “Cookshack” provides Fair visitors a variety of high-quality menu selections at moderate and affordable prices. We offer a variety of selections intended to appeal to our many visitors of all ages. Our kitchen facilities are permitted and inspected during every Fair by the San Mateo County Department of Environmental Health. We historically receive highest cleanliness and sanitation inspection ratings. The Cookshack is operated entirely by community volunteers working to provide our Fair visitors with a positive and enjoyable Fair experience. All profits, including gratuities, benefit the Kings Mountain Volunteer Fire Brigade and educational services and programs at the Kings Mountain Elementary School.

Gluten Free, Vegetarian and Vegan Options on our Menu

Gluten-Free Ingredient Choices:

Our kitchen is not gluten-free. We prepare menu items in our pantry and kitchen, which contain ingredients having gluten such as bread and

buns. Therefore, if you are highly sensitive to gluten, Cookshack menu selections are not appropriate dining choices.

We do offer a variety of **menu selections composed entirely of gluten-free ingredients**. Our famous **Cookshack Chili** is made in-house from sautéed onions, green peppers, garlic; several (rinsed) canned beans; diced tomatoes; chili powder; cumin and tomato paste. All the ingredients are labeled and/or reported by our supplier to be gluten-free. Our **corn chips** served with our chili and nacho selections are labeled as gluten-free. **Mountain Nachos** is a gluten-free menu selection. **Corn on the cob** and our yummy made-in-house **cole slaw** are made from gluten-free ingredients.

Vegetarian/Vegan Choices:

The **corn on the cob** is a vegetarian/vegan choice. Our made-in-house **cole slaw dressing contains mayonnaise** (and, therefore, egg products) but our **cole slaw** is otherwise vegetarian. Our now famous **Cookshack Chili** and accompanying tortilla chips are vegetarian/vegan.

We can prepare **Mountain Nachos** as a vegan menu selection. Ask your server for **Mountain Nachos** without cheese and sour cream. We will be pleased to accommodate your request.

The Cookshack leaves an environmentally friendly footprint.

All food-serving items are compostable except the wine glasses (which are recyclable). The Art Fair has implemented a 'Zero Waste' policy and receptacles for compost, recycling, and trash, with appropriate instructions, are located throughout the grounds. Volunteers can assist you in proper disposal to achieve our "Zero Waste" goal.
